## NEOLOGISMS

**Dystechnia:** A psycho-neurological disorder precipitated by the over-exposure to hyper-electromagnetic technologies, low-level radiation, and the multitude of technological devices (cell phones, computers, microwaves, media bombardment, etc.) that produce ambient static, resulting in a decrease in human sensibilities, intellect, consciousness and tactility. With the advent and use of advanced (extraterrestrial) technology employing terrestrial materials, the Kryogen have duped humankind into willingly and willfully destroying itself.

**Megamite:** An organic element found on Nebhet that is used in the fabrication of uniforms and body armor. Raiment (uniforms & garb) composed of megamite enables the wearer to withstand most conventional weaponry (incl. lasers), windshear, and the trauma of stargate (space/time) travel.

**The Yumiverse:** A neo-reality Heruic paradigm set in the year A.D. 2035 (and told in flashbacks) with 45 characters: 1 flagship (Apadamax aka Asad X.
